- Don't call unfamiliar numbers or reply to unsolicited texts as they may charge premium rates.
- Never assume an email or phone call is authentic.

If you're worried about someone and believe they may be a fraud victim contact Action Fraud **0300 123 2040**. You can also report scams on this number.

STAY SAFE AT ALL TIMES; keep handbags closed, shield your pin number at cash point machines, be wary of distraction theft! LOCK your doors at all times... the police have advised to keep lights and a radio/TV on if you go out in the evenings. Keep all back entrances secure and locked.
