STAY SAFE - SCAM WATCH

There is a recent scam where scammers pretending to be companies like BT, Talk Talk etc. have been calling people and saying they need remote access to your computer. They then use this access to steal things like your bank details!

Genuine companies will never phone you out of the blue and ask to access your computer, so don't give them access! If you're not sure if a call is legitimate, hang up, get the genuine customer services number from the company's website and call that for verification.

If you get someone at the door saying they are from a company and need access to your house, you should find that company's number online or through the Yellow Pages and ring that to ask them if they've sent people out to your house. Don't ring a number people on your doorstop give you as this can be fake!

To report fraud or get advice, you can <u>call Action Fraud on 0300 123 2040</u>. Let us know if you encounter any scams so we can warn other people!
