

Also on site there's a display on the history of the gardens, and an art exhibition on British Wildflowers, featuring 3 accomplished artists, in the restored Coach House.


When you get hungry or need to warm up, the five star tearoom on site serves delicious homemade food, from soup and jacket potatoes to cream teas.
